

GP Connect Send Document for PCN Hubs


The GP Connect Send Document messaging functionality supports consultations held at another healthcare organisation by sending a summary of the encounter (consultation) back to the patient's registered organisation (i.e. for extended hours support) in a PDF file.

NHS England uses a national standard called [Fast Healthcare Interoperability Resources \(FHIR\)](#) for sharing healthcare data. This standard will be used in EMIS Web when sending and [receiving](#) messages to ensure patient data can be easily shared between different organisations. Message senders are NHS organisations. Message receivers are GP organisations.

Activating GP Connect Send Document

Access Organisation Configuration. Click , point to **Configuration**, and then select **Organisation Configuration**. The Organisation Configuration screen is displayed.


1. In the navigation pane, click **Organisation**.
2. On the ribbon, click **Edit**. The Edit Organisation screen is displayed.
3. In the left-hand pane, click **GP Connect Configuration**. The GP Connect Configuration screen is displayed.



4. Select **GP Connect Messaging - Send Consultation (Encounter) Summary**

GP Connect Messaging doesn't require GP Connect to be [activated](#).

5. In the left-hand pane, click **GP Connect Messaging Configuration**. The GP Connect Messaging Configuration screen is displayed with all available patient types listed.



6. Within this screen set the patient type default setting to automatically send or not send a consultation back to the patient's GP organisation.
